# **Industry News**

### **Demand for Roofing to Reach 252 Million Squares**

THE FREEDONIA GROUP INC., Cleveland, has released a "Roofing" Study about industry trends through 2019. According to the study, US demand for roofing is projected to advance 3.9 percent annually to 252 million

squares in 2019, valued at 21.4 billion. Driven by a fast growing residential market, demand for steep/slope roofing is forecast to increase more rapidly than demand for low slope roofing.

Demand for asphalt shingles is forecast to rise at an above average pace through 2019 as a result of a rebound in housing. Roofing tiles are expected to see the most rapid growth of all roofing products, driving by housing starts in the South and West, where roofing tiles most often are installed.
